Taipei Municipal Lanya Junior High School

Lanya Junior High School initiated its international education program in 2008 through the Connecting Classroom Online Community project. In 2013, the school further integrated international education into specialized courses and joined the SIEP project. With the support of dedicated faculty and administration, the school has continued to refine and expand its curricula, fostering a positive and engaged school culture.

The school's comprehensive international education program, "Lanya: A World of Love and Learning," is structured around three core dimensions: culture, ecosystem, and human rights. Each dimension encompasses four courses, integrated across various subject areas. These courses follow a three-step learning process: understanding, inquiry, and sharing, which empowers students to explore global issues and develop respect for diverse cultures. Through a "learning by doing" approach, students acquire essential skills and enhance their global mobility, fostering a strong sense of identity and personal responsibility through reflection and presentation. By implementing these courses, the school aims to equip students with the international literacy necessary to become informed and engaged global citizens in the 21st century.
