### Modeled/Guided Practice:

- **Definitions:** Teach necessary vocabulary. (5 minutes)
  - Chick: A baby bird
  - Easter Egg: A decorated egg given at easter
  - Basket: A container used to carry or hold things
  - Jellybean: A popular type of candy. They are hard on the outside and soft in the inside.
  - Chocolate: A sweet made out of ground cacao seeds
  - Bunny: A small rabbit
  - April: The fourth month of the year
  - Egg Hunt: Easter eggs are hidden for children to find
  - Family: A group of people who are related to each other
  - Tulip: A flower that comes in early spring. They are very colorful.
  
- **Teach about Easter**
- Easter Bunny - a symbol of Easter who brings fun dyed eggs that are filled with candy and gifts
- Easter egg hunt - family activity and event that takes place. Eggs are scattered or hidden around a yard or large field for kids to find and put in their baskets. These eggs are also colored and filled with candy and prizes.
- Easter egg dying - an activity where you can color eggs to make them look pretty and stand out during this holiday. This is usually done with hot water, vinegar, and food coloring.
- Easter candy - popular Easter candies that come in the eggs and baskets are Cadbury eggs, peeps, milk chocolate eggs, Reese's peanut butter eggs, hollow chocolate bunnies, and Easter m&ms
- **Easter Activities**
  - How Many Eggs?
    - We will count how many eggs there are altogether.
      - Starting at 1, then go up by one.

- Then I will ask how many eggs there are with different colors.
  - Ex: how many eggs are pink? Ans: 4
  - Until we get all the eggs and their colors.
- Freeze Dance
  - Dance when the bunny and Jack dance and then stop when they say freeze.
- Repeat After Me
  - Repeat the song after the man sings it.
