

## ☆ Brief History

Formerly known as “The Fourth High School of Taihoku Prefecture,” the school was established during the Japanese occupation era. In 1949, it was taken over by the republican government and renamed “Taipei City Primary School of Agriculture.” In 1955, the school was renamed again as “Taipei Municipal High School of Agriculture.” The school name was renewed as “Taipei Municipal Vocational High School of Agriculture” in 1964. In 1967, the school was renamed as “Taipei Municipal Heping Senior High School.” One year later, with more programs added, the school was relocated to the current site under the name “Taipei Municipal School of Agriculture and Industry.” Finally, in 1981, the school was officially named as “Songshan High School of Agriculture and Industry” (SAIHS) until the present day.
