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# <About LYGSH----The First Girls' Senior High School in Yilan>

(Brief History)

National Lan-Yang Girls' Senior High School was founded during the Japanese reign in 1938. Initially, the school was named "Taipei State Lan-Yang Girls' High School". It was the first high school for female students in Yilan.

In 2000, as it came under the jurisdiction of Ministry of Education, the name was changed into "National Lan-Yang Girls' Senior High School."



Our motto, "Truth, Goodness and Beauty (真善美)", is embodied in the acts and spirit of the students and alumni. LYGSH has a reputation for artistic and linguistic excellence in Yilan County.

# <Campus Life>

#### 1. Campus Description

Our school covers an area of 45,816 square meters. There are ten buildings around the athletic field, including the Administration Building, Instructional Building, Dance Building, Science Building, Gym, Auditorium, Activity Center, Art building, Library, and Music Building.





#### 2. School Position

The school is situated in Yilan City, the biggest city in Yilan County, located in Northeastern Taiwan. It's about 1.3 kilometers from the train station, and an hour's drive away from Taipei, the capital of Taiwan.

# 3. Student & Faculty

Currently, we have 42 classes in total, including three language-gifted classes, three special math/science classes, and three classes for dance-talented students. A normal class has around 40-45 students, while special classes only have a maximum of 30 students. The faculty consists of approximately 100 members.

#### 4. Uniform & Tradition

Students in LYGSH are known for their uniforms, or the so-called to "blue blouse." In fact, they are often referred as "girls in blue blouses" by citizens. The blue blouse is our symbol, representing the energy of youth.

Another traditional characteristic of LYGSH is folk dance. Students learn how to dance the folk dances in PE class, and perform the dances twice a week (Monday & Thursday) as well as on significant occasions such as the school anniversary.



#### 5. Annual Activities

There are events such as the School Anniversary Carnival, English Drama Contest, English Speech Contest, school orchestra performances, sports contests, and science camps on holidays, to name just a few.



## <Curriculum>

LYGSH offers high quality curricula with comprehensive courses. Aside from normal courses, students can also attend optional courses of all kinds. There are electives for cooking, dancing, handicrafts, astronomy and more.





#### <Gifted/Talented Classes>

Our school has established three special classes for talented or gifted students, including:

1. Language Gifted Class: This class was established in 2003. Students should take specific tests in order to get into this class. LYGSH's Language-Gifted Class boasts writing courses and diverse activities, in which students can find their potential and demonstrate their talents.



**2.Mathematic Experimental Class**: Set up in 2004, this class welcomes students who are good at math or science. Besides academic




performance, students from this class also shine in extracurricular activities such as science fairs.
